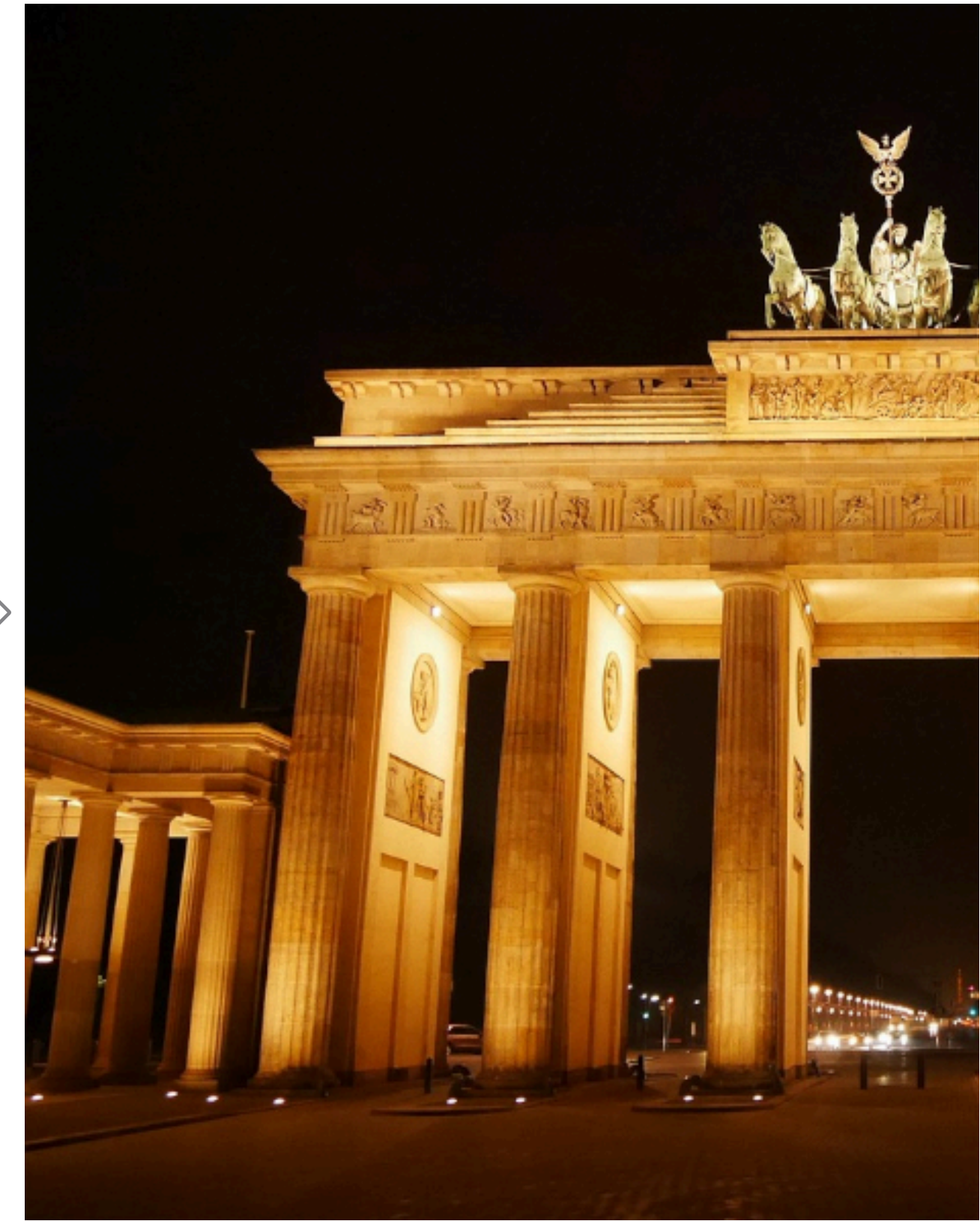


International Lions Youth Camp NH 2025
